On behalf of all our members, I sincerely thank our dedicated Team of volunteers that comprise the Committee Members of BoatingWA. We are a "Not for Profit Organisation" working diligently to safeguard the interests of all Western Australia Recreational Boaters.

Our number one priority remains serving as ***THE VOICE*** of our members and advocating for our members and our boating community as a whole. We are much stronger when we act and voice opinion together!

In 2020-2021, your continued commitment to Boating Western Australia has enabled us to:

- Advocate for recreational members and protect the boating community's interests throughout regular meetings with Government Departments and Authorities.

BoatingWA has worked tirelessly to ensure a fair and safe boating year for all recreational boaters. As a result, you were able to claim a refund on moorings and entry fee at Rottnest Island for the period of the Covid19-Quarantining.

- Offer problem-solving services to Government and regulatory bodies. You can now travel the Swan River safely, thanks to BoatingWA's involvement in monitoring the excessive speed of vessels and implementing the "smiley face" initiative. The Department of Transport have purchased 11 of these signs to further the process of educating boaters and improving boating habits on the Swan River. Trials are now planned for Rottnest Island and they have already been trialled at Mandurah.

- Ensure the development of appropriate facilities for recreational boating. In partnership with the Rottnest island and Authority and Club Marine, Boating Western Australia have established six new moorings in Longreach – ensuring yet another safe mooring and free holiday destination point for the boaters of Western Australia. Paid for by BoatingWA for the safety and enjoyment of Boaters.

- Provide timely communications about issues that impact the boating community through our monthly e-Newsletter "On Deck", our website and Facebook page.
- Encourage boating safety with initiative such as the BoatingWA Life jacket upgrade – trade in program. Make sure you get the latest Life Jackets at a discounted price under the BoatingWA and DOT joint educational program!
