Web Privacy Policy

This following document sets forth the Privacy Policy for Boating Western Australia (BoatingWA) website, www.boatingwa.com.au.

Boating Western Australia is committed to providing you with the best possible customer service experience. BoatingWA is bound by the Privacy Act 1988, which sets out a number of principles concerning the privacy of individuals.

1. Use of your Personal information:

BoatingWA is committed to safeguarding personal privacy. It recognizes that individuals have a right to control how their personal information is collected and used. Providing personal information is an act of trust and it is taken seriously. Unless given consent to do otherwise, BoatingWA will only collect and use personal information as set out below.

2. Collecting personal information:

3. Use of tracking technologies:

BoatingWA uses tracking technologies such as cookies or web beacons to make use of the website and services as convenient as possible. Cookies are pieces of information that a web site transfers to a computer's hard disk for record keeping purposes. Most web browsers are set to accept tracking technologies such as cookies or web beacons. These tracking technologies do not themselves personally identify users, although they do identify a user's browser.

- To send newsletters.
